

### 51133 - When the drum's skin has become slack/soft

Be completely calm. It is completely normal for natural leather to become "soft" due to humidity in the air. If the skin has become loose, it can be repaired very easily.

- Turn the drum with the skin downwards
- Pour a large glass of water in it (½-1 liter)
- Put it in a tub or a place that can handle some leaking
- Leave it overnight so that the skin is completely wet
- Pour the water out of the drum
- Leave the drum standing with the skin down, on a plate for a day (e.g. laminate)
- After that day, place the drum with the skin facing up, preferably in a cool but dry room, maybe use a fan, and then let it dry up for approx. one day.

Then the skin should be tight again.
